	Fundraising (Tom Wigginton) - In past years we have had a lot of small fundraisers throughout the year, which has been cumbersome for families on such a frequent basis. We are trying to minimize number of fundraisers we are holding. New program now is the Monthly Subscriptions in which families can donate a monthly amount for 9-10 months depending on when you sign up. Suggested is \$40/month, but you can do more or less, whatever fits your budget. One-time donations are accepted as well. You can share the link with family, neighbors, etc. so they can donate on behalf of a Centennial Family. If successful, this makes previous fundraising efforts more of a community event, i.e. Annual Soiree. We need to be at about a 55,000 to a 60,000/year for fundraising to meet all of our goals. Not all fundraising done throughout the year is a PTA fundraiser, Fun Run and AHA Fundraiser are Miss Marcely's Fundraisers so these are separate events.
