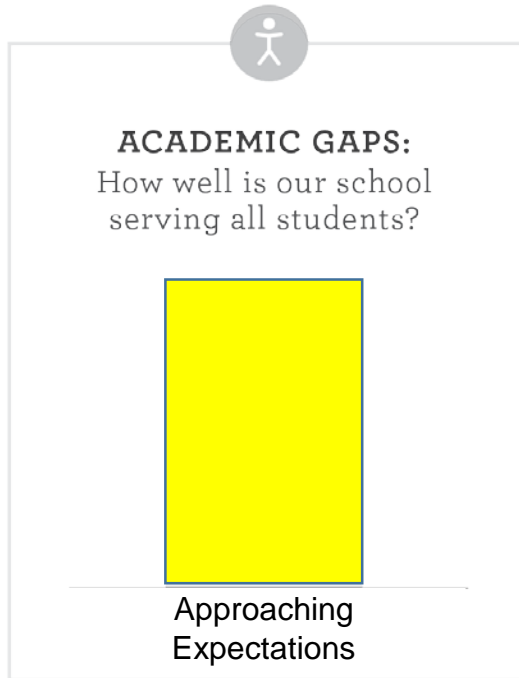

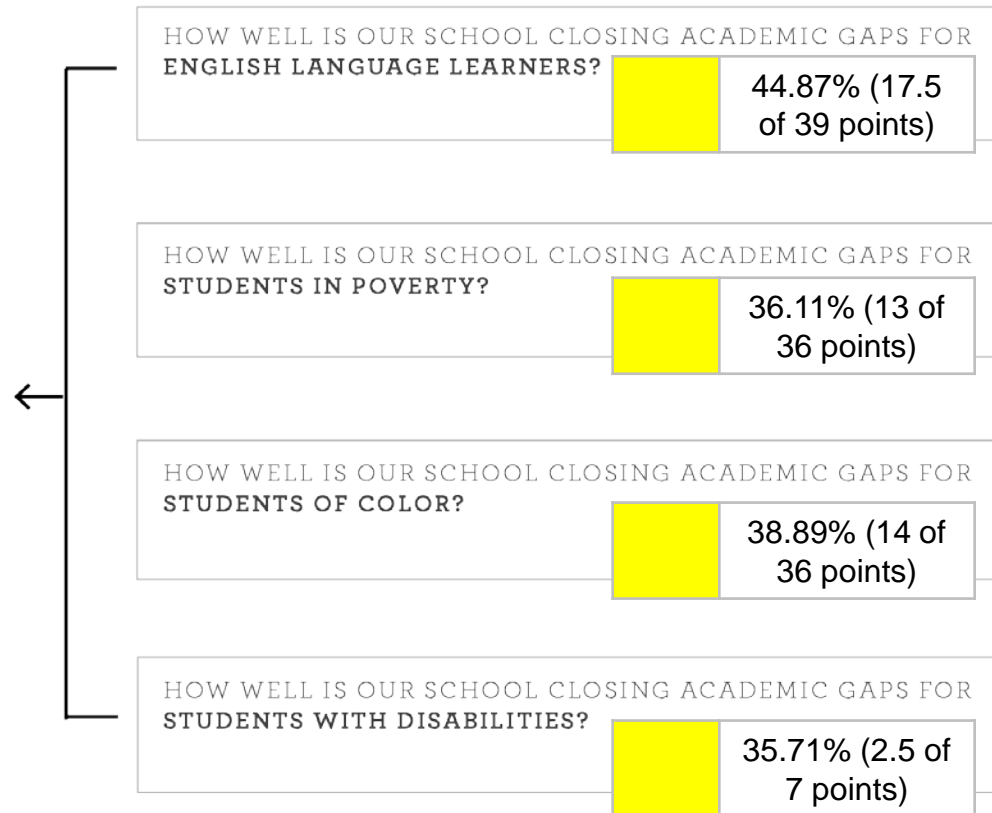


Academic Gaps are an important area of focus on the School Performance Framework.
