FAQ'S

* When are PTA meetings?

PTA meetings are the third Tuesday of every month from 6:30-7:30 p.m. This year, families can also call in if attending is not convenient. On-site childcare is always provided as a courtesy. Our lives are full & making time for PTA can often be tough. Come when you can and know that just one meeting can do a lot to support our school. We have a Membership Drive Tuesday August 27th at 5:30pm and our first official PTA Meeting is Tuesday September 17th 6:30pm in the Library.

* Why become a PTA member?

Membership gives you the power to vote. Do you want to have authority over what PTA funds? Decide whether our PTA endorses measures or legislation affecting education at the county and state level? Become a member. You can pay your dues any time during the school year. One minute before a vote is never too late!

* What do your PTA membership dues pay for?

Individual memberships are \$10; family memberships (two adults) are \$15. About 2/3's of those dues cover our fees to the state and national PTA boards. The remaining portion goes to operating costs like our liability insurance. Teacher/Staff receive a discounted rate of \$6.25.

*** Reminder: The PTA is more than a fundraising group for the school. We are an advocacy organization focused on student success. PTA fosters collaborative engagement between parents, teachers, students, staff and the community.**
